The Embassy received a few queries regarding the "COVID-19 Negative certificate", raised by some of the stranded Bangladeshis willing to avail the upcoming special chartered flight of Qatar Airways arranged by the government of Bangladesh.

In this regard, the Embassy would like to share the following clarifications received from the charter company/airline:

- i. A passenger does not actually need to go through a physical 'COVID-19 test' to get this certificate.
- ii. The passenger can obtain a 'certificate' or "To Whom it May Concern" note from any doctor/medical practitioner/health care provider at any place in USA <u>simply stating that the person has been examined by the doctor/certificate provider and he/she apparently does not have any COVID-19 related symptoms.</u>
- iii. As such, the passengers will need to submit a "COVID-19 Symptom free certificate" prior to get on board the special flight.

Hope the above clarification would facilitate the interested passengers in obtaining the "COVID-19 Symptom free certificate" ahead of their travel.
