Govt. of the People's Republic of Bangladesh through the Bangladesh diplomatic representative in the country of the candidate's domicile or the diplomatic representative of the candidate's Mission in Bangladesh. If the proposed admission is in pursuance of the agreement between the Govt. of Bangladesh & the Govt. of applicant's country of domicile, the application has to be routed through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of that country of domicile.
4. All certificates and mark sheets essentially be attested by the Foreign Ministry of the respective countries of the candidates without which no application will be entertained.
5. Only for MBBS and BDS courses the applicant must enclose a non-refundable demand draft of US\$50 or BDT 3500/-

Criteria for Admission of Foreign Students in the MBBS and BDS courses in the Government-owned medical colleges in Bangladesh for 2011-2012 academic year under self-finance scheme.

A) Equivalence of Foreign Degree:

- Must have passed qualifying examinations (HSC/ 'A' level) or equivalent examination.
- SSC/ 'O' or equivalent examination passed not before 2008
- HSC/ 'A' or equivalent examination passed not before 2010
- Minimum aggregate GPA in SSC and HSC: 8.00 (eight)
- Minimum GPA either in SSC or in HSC: 3.50
- For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in SSC/ 'O' level or equivalent exam, only top 5 subjects are considered for calculation of GPA. Therefore, GPA in 'O' level = (total marks obtained in top five subjects)/5
- For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in HSC/ 'A' level or equivalent exam, only 3 subjects (physics, Chemistry, and Biology) are considered for calculation of GPA. Qualifying grade in each subject individually is "C". Therefore, GPA in 'A' level = (total marks obtained in three subjects)/3

B) Application Form: Duly filled in application forms in triplicate along with following documents and 6 passport size photographs are to reach the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Dhaka by 30 October 2011

- All certificates must be duly attested by the competent authority, i.e., the Foreign Ministry of the respective country.
- Successful applicants will require to produce all academic certificates and mark sheets/ transcripts in original during their admission.

C) Tuition Fees: For Government medical and dental colleges students have to pay \$3000 (three thousand) per academic year in addition to the tuition fees charged to a Bangladeshi Student. Information regarding tuition fees for private medical and dental colleges can be obtained directly from the college concerned.

D) Application fees: Each applicant must attach with his/her application a non-refundable demand draft of US\$50(fifty) payable to: "The Director, Medical Education and HMPD, DGHS, Mohakhali, Dhaka, Bangladesh.

E) Only the application transmitted through Bangladesh Missions abroad or through the Missions in Dhaka of respective country will be considered for admission. Applications must reach Bangladesh Embassy in Washington, DC by 22 October 2011.
